

ST. LOUIS AQUARIUM FOUNDATION ESSAY CONTEST

The St. Louis Aquarium Foundation is announcing our 3rd Annual Aquatic Animal Essay Contest! Students in grades K-12 are invited to submit a 1-2 page written response to the question for their age group (drawings, if included, do not count as one of the written pages) for a chance to win free tickets to the St. Louis Aquarium and St. Louis Wheel.

Essays must be hand-written, in the student's own writing*. Entries may be submitted by one of the following methods:

- Emailing photos of the hand-written essay to <u>education@stlaquariumfoundation.org</u> by no later than 11:59 pm on **Friday, April 22, 2022.** Please make the subject of your email "Essay Contest (student's name) (student's grade level)"
- Dropping it off in person at the Conservation & Education Center welcome desk at Union Station (201 S. 18th Street, St. Louis, M0 63103) no later than 7 pm on Friday, April 22, 2022. Please label it with your child's name and grade level.

Rules, Entry Instructions, & Prizes

Essays will be evaluated based on the creativity and skill in answering the question; spelling and grammar will be considered as well. Essays must be written by hand, by the student in their own words*. Please include the student's name and grade level on the submission. One winner and two runners-up will be selected from each age group. First place winners will receive a certificate good for 4 free St. Louis Aquarium admissions, 4 free St. Louis Wheel admissions, and a \$25 gift card to the Aquarium Gift Shop. The two runners-up in each age bracket will receive 2 free St. Louis Aquarium admissions and 2 free St. Louis Wheel admissions.

Essays must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian of any student under the age of 18. By submitting an essay, permission is granted for the St. Louis Aquarium Foundation to use the essays (and any corresponding artwork) on their website, social media pages, or for any publicity/marketing purposes.

LOUIS AQUARIUM FOUNDATION ESSAY CONTEST (THE "CONTEST") YOU ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT YOU HAVE REVIEWED, UNDERSTAND, AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ALL OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS STATED HEREIN. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, DO NOT ENTER THE CONTEST.

- 1. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>. The Contest is open to students who are in grades kindergarten through twelve (12) and who are legal residents of the United States. Employees and non-employee workers of the St. Louis Aquarium at Union Station Foundation d/b/a the St. Louis Aquarium Foundation (the "<u>Sponsor</u>") and its affiliates, prize providers, agents and agencies involved in the Contest, as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and household members of each such ineligible person, are not eligible for entry into the Contest. THE CONTEST IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. - 2. <u>CONTEST PERIOD</u>: During the period beginning on March14, 2022 and ending at 11:59 p.m. CDT, April 22, 2022 (the "<u>Contest Period</u>"), you may enter the Contest using the Method of Entry set forth in these Terms and Conditions. The Sponsor's computer is the official time keeping device for the Contest.
- 3. <u>METHOD OF ENTRY</u>: During the Contest Period, you may enter the Contest by emailing photos of your child's <u>handwritten essay</u> to <u>arodgers@stlaquariumfoundation.org</u>, or in person at the Conservation & Education Center located at St. Louis Union Station at 201 S. 18th St., St. Louis, MO 63103. Essays must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian of any entrant under the age of 18. Limit: 1 essay per entrant. All entries become the exclusive property of the Sponsor, and none will be acknowledged or returned. Proof of sending or submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by the Sponsor. The Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, illegible or misdirected entries, which will be disqualified. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY; A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. NO IN-PERSON ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE SPONSOR.
- 4. <u>PRIZE</u>: There will be one winner per each age group as more fully described on the Contest Main Page. Individual prizes and the methods of judging are more fully described on the Contest Main Page. No substitution for a prize by winner. - 5. <u>WINNER NOTIFICATION</u>: Winners will be notified by electronic mail the week of May 2, 2022. In addition, winners will be posted on the Sponsor's Facebook page and website.
